

Eligibility Criteria for

Dwight A. Hamilton Scottish Rite Foundation of Colorado Speech-Language Pathology Graduate Student Scholarship and/or

Colorado Masons Benevolent Fund Speech-Language Pathology Graduate Student Scholarship

The Scottish Rite Foundation of Colorado and the Colorado Masons Benevolent Fund are pleased to offer competitively awarded \$5,000.00 scholarships to graduate students in speech-language pathology. Students who meet the following requirements may apply for a scholarship:

- 1. Successfully completed the first year of graduate study in speech-language pathology with a grade point average of 3.5 (B+) or higher.
- 2. Enrolled as a second-year graduate student in speech-language pathology at either the University of Colorado Boulder or the University of Northern Colorado.
- 3. Recognized as a Colorado resident by the university by the application deadline (June 15); proof of residency is required.
- 4. Committed to a career treating children with childhood language disorders.
- 5. Planning to remain in Colorado after graduation to serve children in this state. Special consideration will be given to applicants who are interested in serving children in rural or underserved areas of Colorado.

Application Requirements

Graduate students who meet the above qualifications may apply for one of these Masonic scholarships by submitting:

- 1. Official transcript or academic progress report (first year graduate study)
- 2. Proof of Colorado residency as defined by the university's criteria
- One-page, double-spaced statement on career goals and aspirations including a description of student's interest in serving children with language disorders and intention to remain in Colorado
- 4. One letter of recommendation from university faculty
- 5. One letter of recommendation from clinical supervisor
- 6. One-page professional resume
- 7. Please include your personal diversity statement
- 8. Completed approval form for information sharing
- 9. Application checklist showing application completeness
